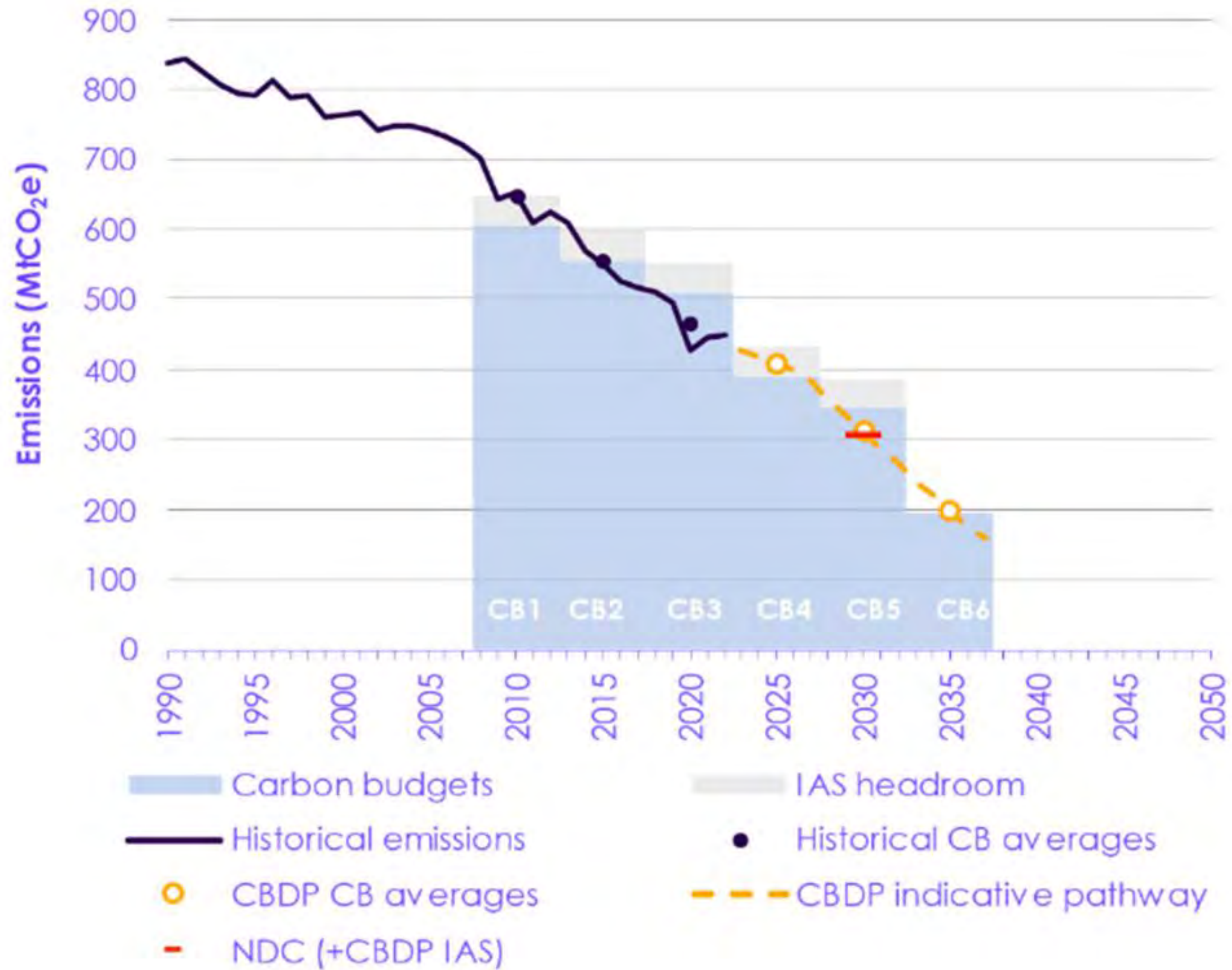

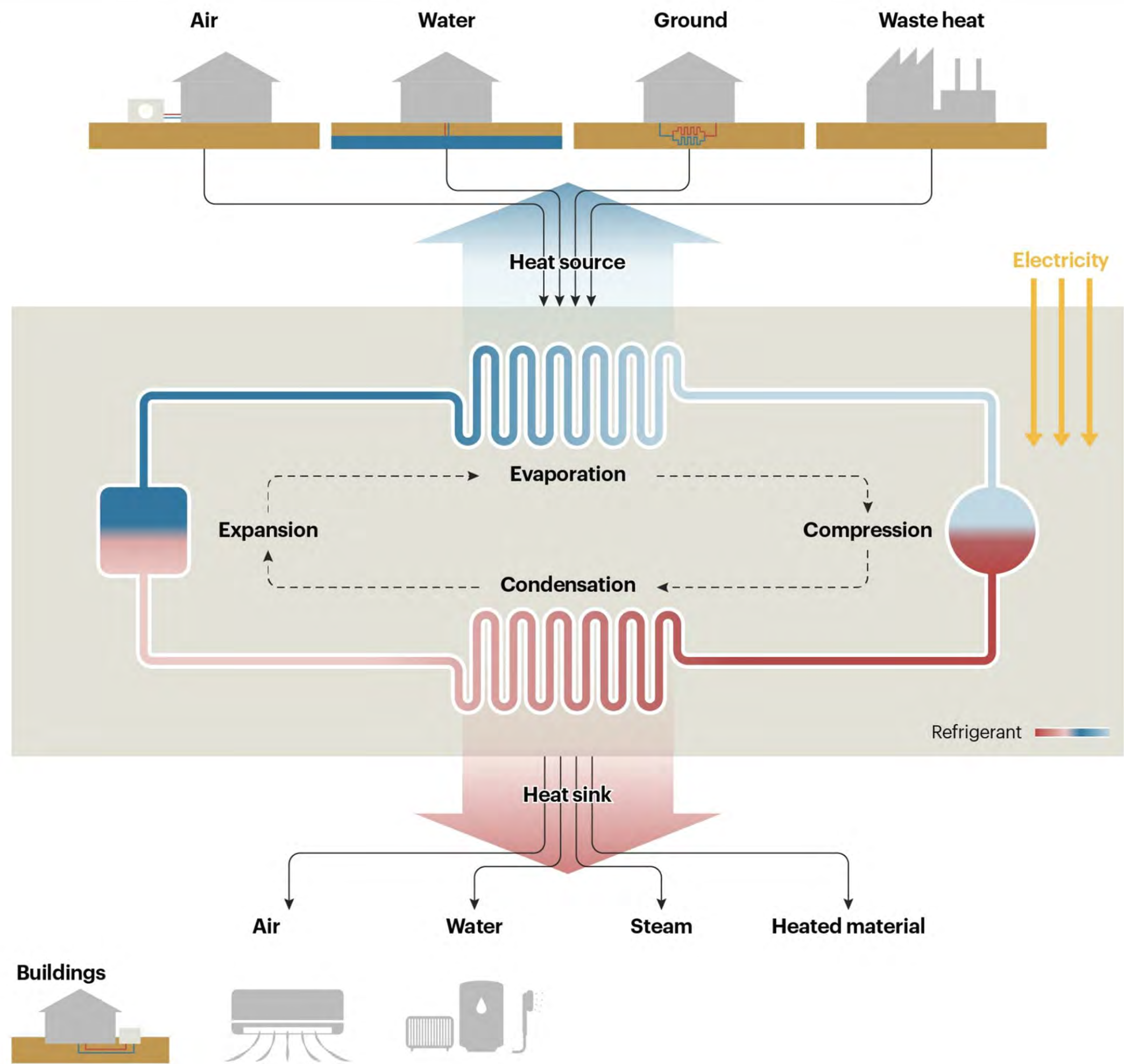
Up to 300,000 homes to benefit from upgrades next year, as government continues rollout of the Warm Homes Plan.

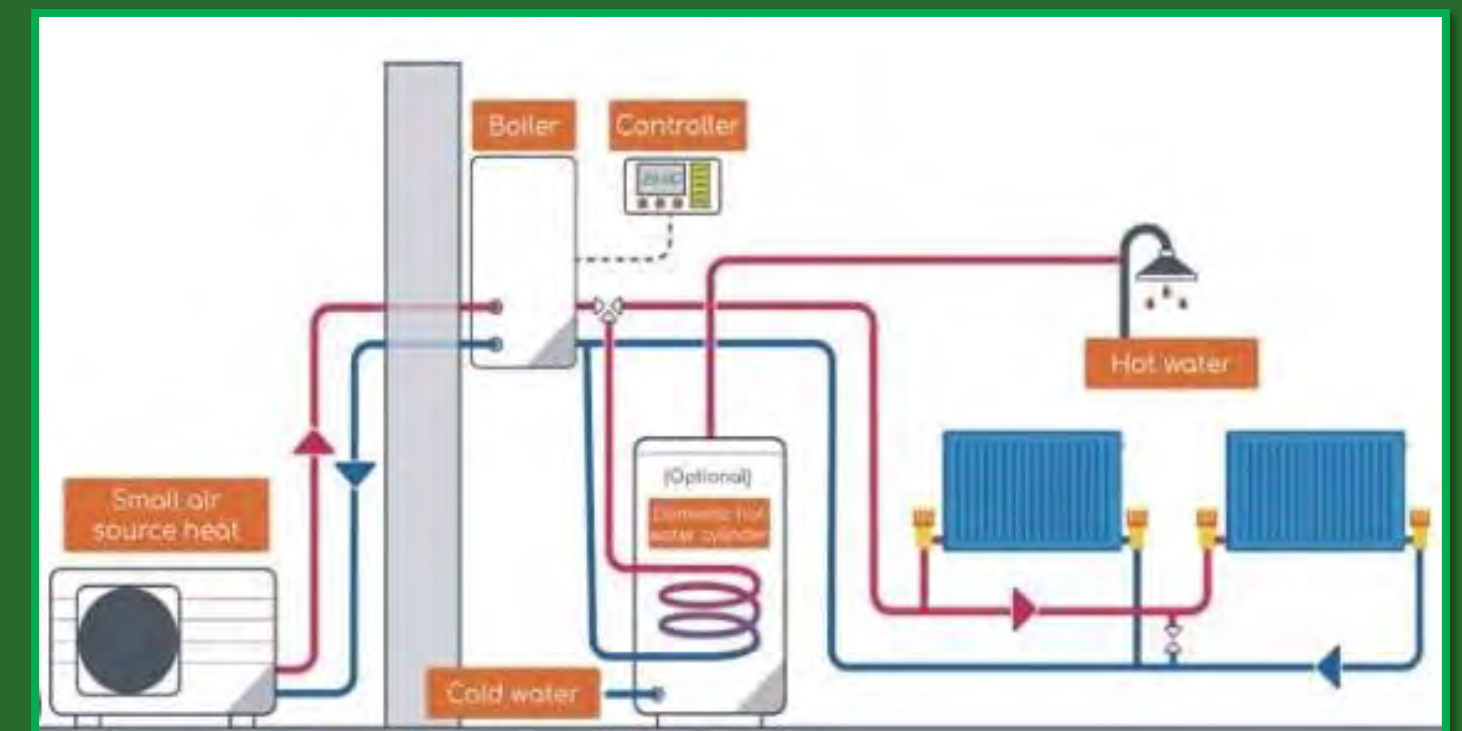

Hybrid Heat Pump Systems

Key Benefits:

High Efficiencies – meaning heat pumps use sometimes up to 5x less energy than fossil fuel heat sources to generate the same amount of heat.

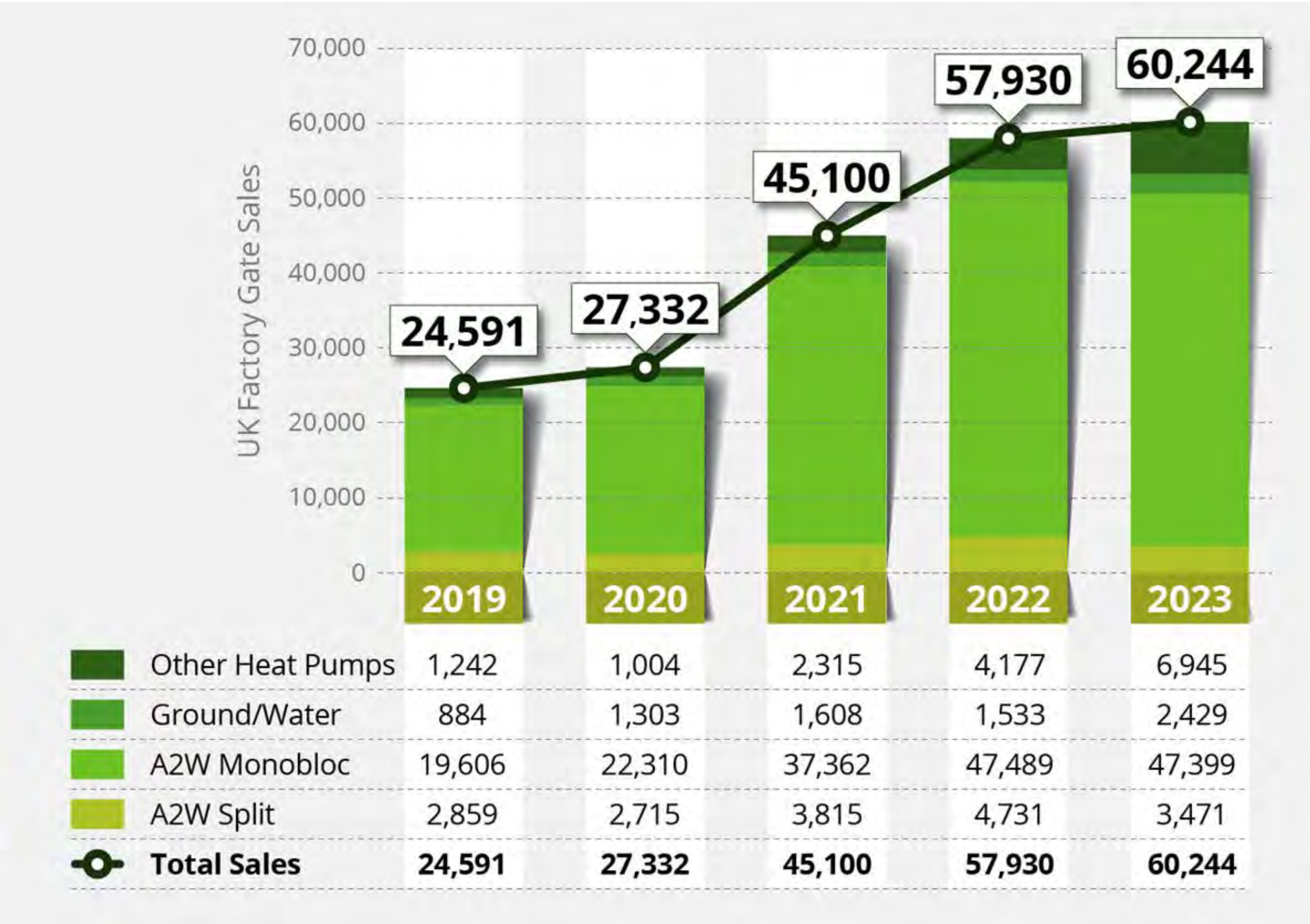
Lower carbon – reducing carbon emissions by up to 80% compared to a gas boiler (possible higher once the grid decarbonises further)

Longer life – Heat pumps can last up to 20 years

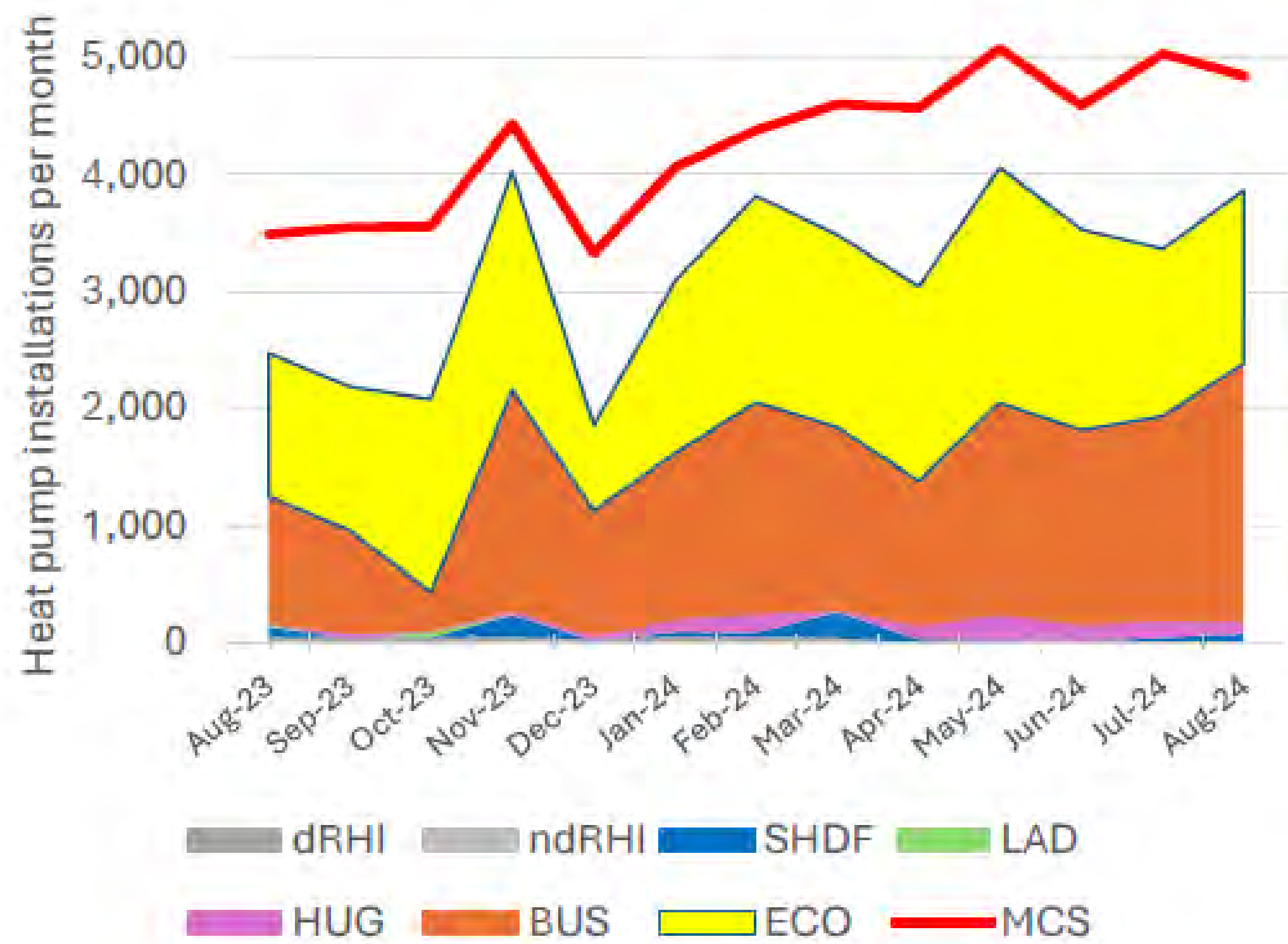

UK Heat Pump Factory Gate Sales by Type

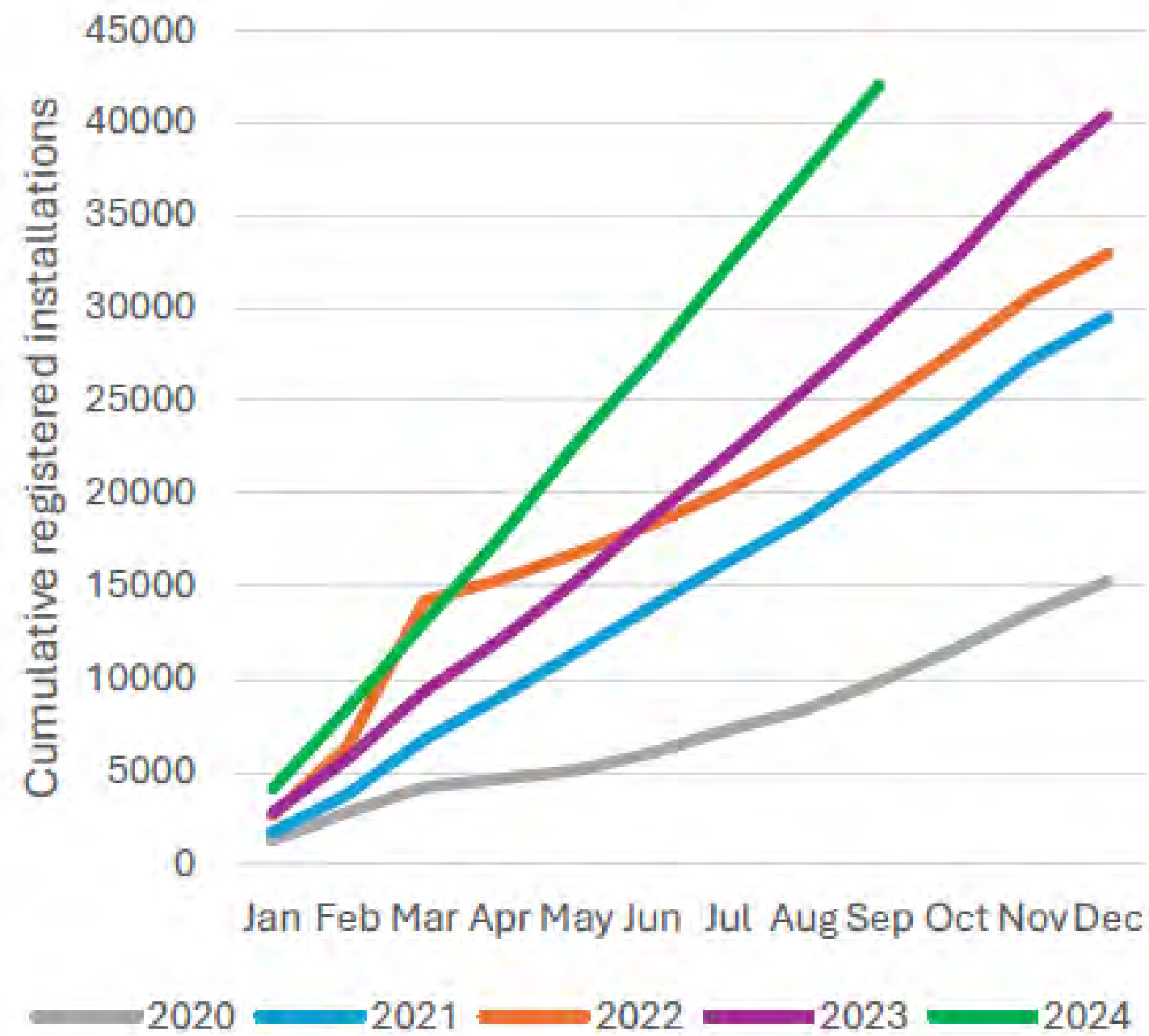
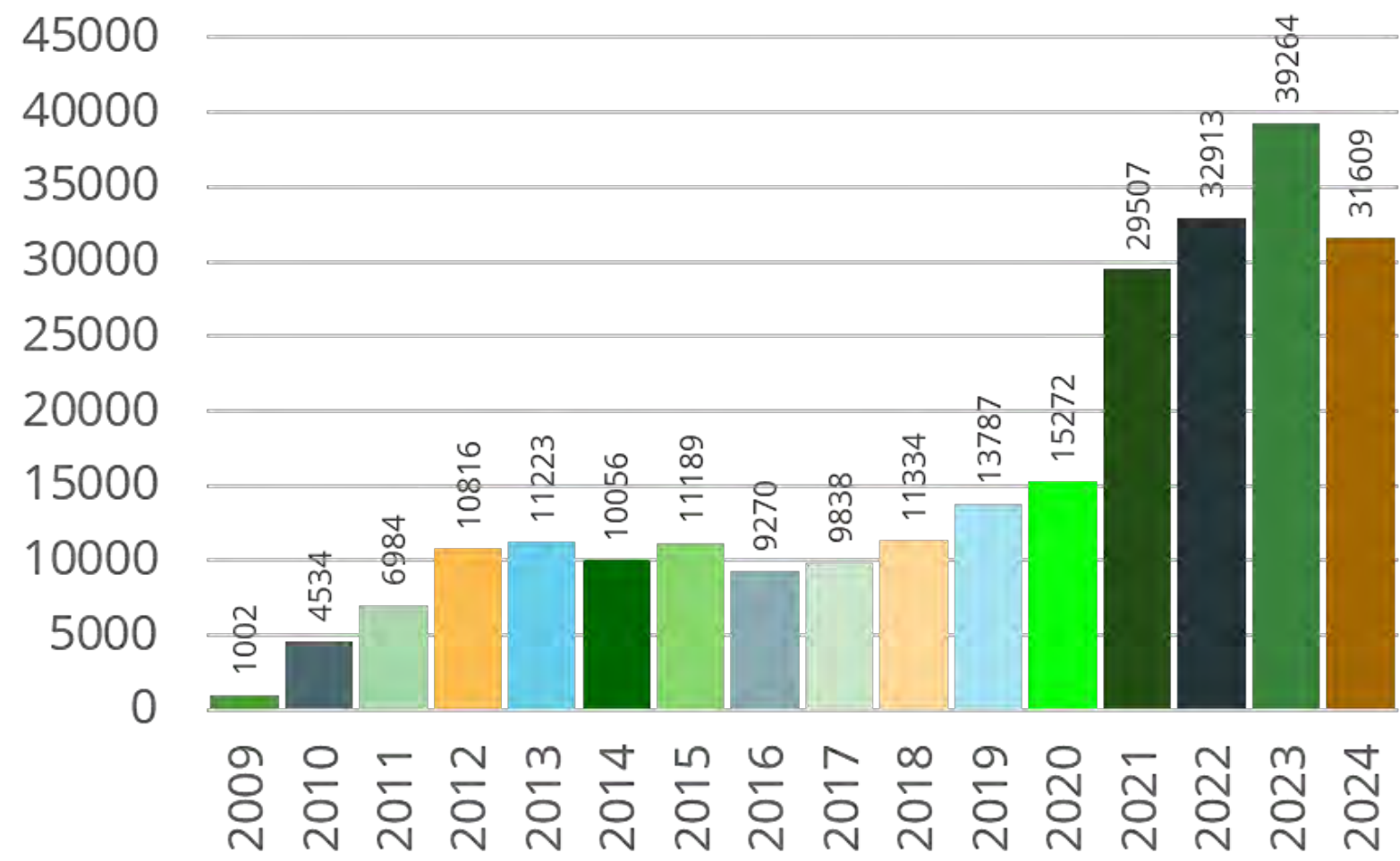


Heat Pumps supported by Government Scheme



MCS Registered Installations

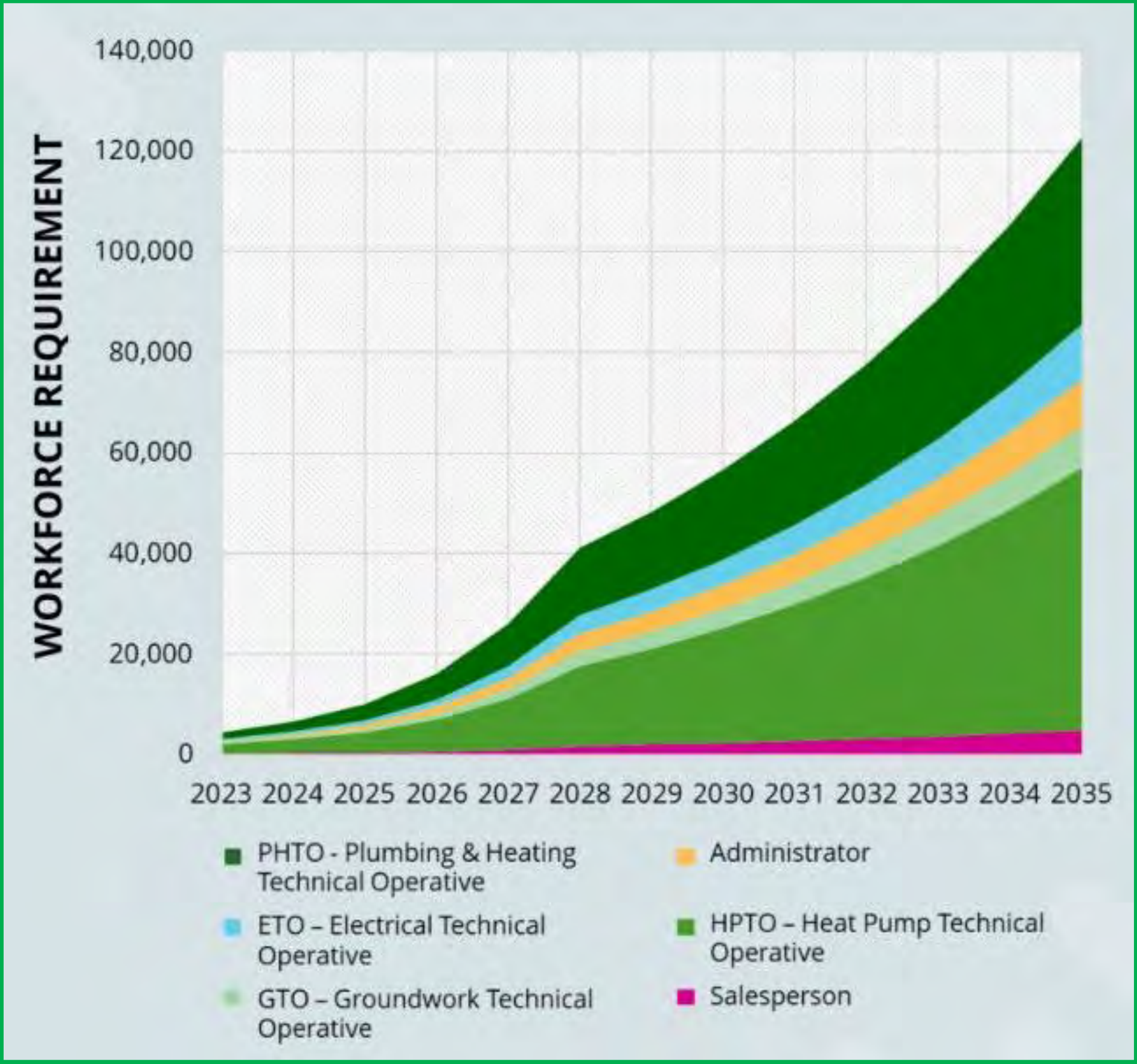
MCS Registered Heat Pump Installations
2009-2024



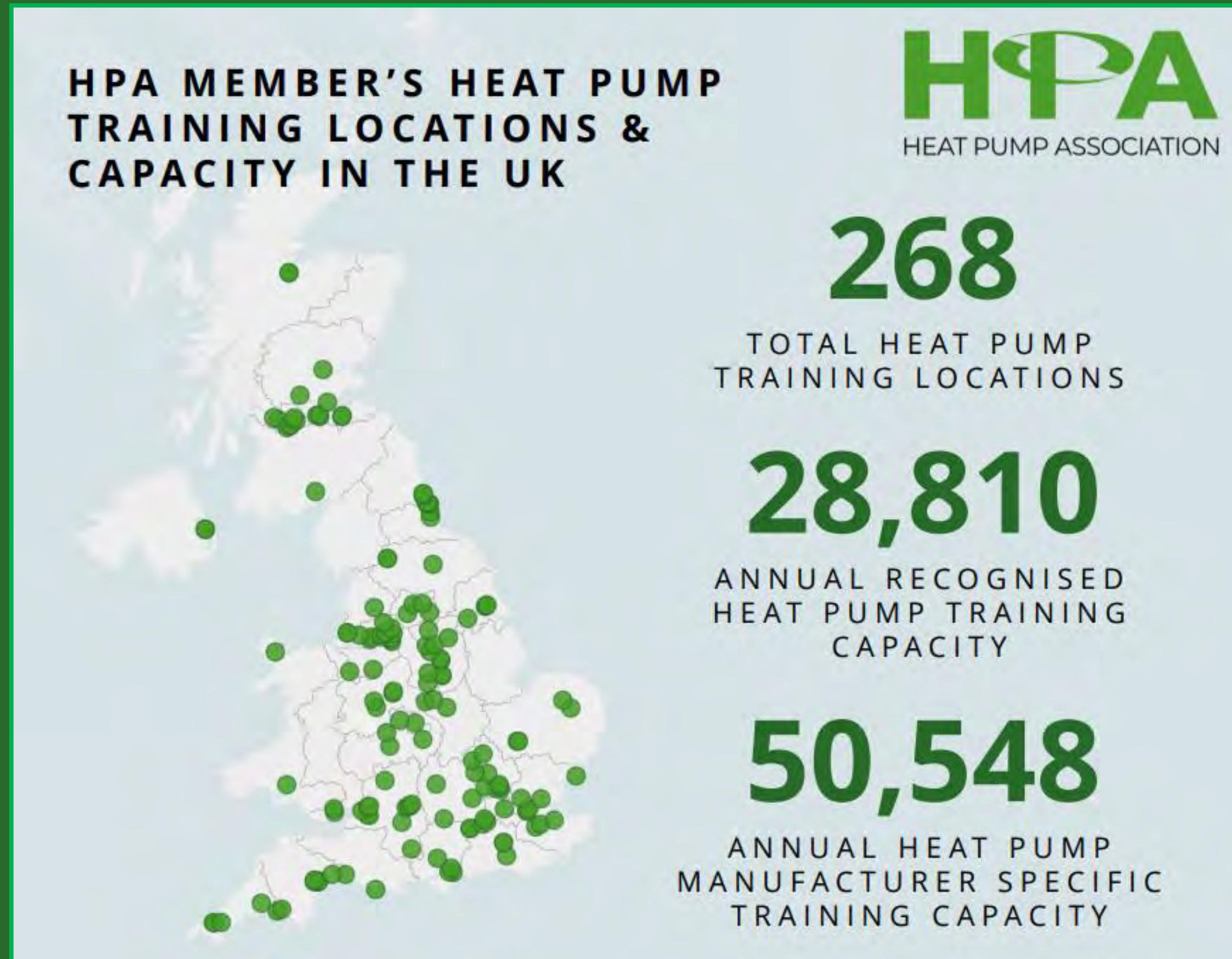
Number of Individuals Trained to install Heat Pumps in the UK

Guidance

Uses of F gas (HFCs) exempt from the phase down

Uses of hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) not included in the phase down that do not count towards your quota, and rules on labelling, selling and reporting exempt HFCs.

Closed consultation

Home Energy Model: replacement for the Standard Assessment Procedure (SAP)

The Future looks bright

Warm Homes Plan – clean, cheaper heating for millions of homes

Boiler Upgrade Scheme – budget increase (£295 million for the next financial year)

Changes to ease planning barriers – removing the 1m rule

Warm Homes: Social Housing Fund and Local Grant

Plans to consult on increase energy efficiency standards for rented homes by 2030

Plan to increase energy efficiency standards for new boilers and heat pumps

Introduction of the Clean Heat Market Mechanism (1st April 2025)

Heat Pump Investment Accelerator competition funding for manufacturers
